
INFTA-Certified Forest Therapy Guide Training in demand in the USA and Canada

INFTA’s Secretary - Honorary Associate Professor, Deakin University, Australia



Dr. Dieter Kotte, INFTA’s Secretary & International Strategic Advisor, has been appointed Honorary Associate Professor by the Faculty of Health, Deakin University, Australia.

This appointment is primarily regarded as a recognition of INFTA’s efforts nationally and internationally to endorse evidence-based Forest Therapy as an effective, affordable Public health practice. Dr. Kotte will use this appointment to strengthen further academic collaborations and research projects. His aim is to set up a new Strategic Research and Innovation Center with a focus on investigating and endorsing the effectiveness of Forest Therapy for Public health systems around the world in order to contain the increasing expenses for and detrimental health effects of lifestyle diseases.

Deakin University – named after [Alfred Deakin](#), the second [Prime Minister of Australia](#) – ranks as the **No. 1 university in Australia** with the highest enrolment of national students across all faculties. At present, nearly 65,000 students study at Deakin University which comprises several campuses and affiliated offices in Australia and Asia.
